In **Landscape Architecture**, ***Benjakitti Forest Park in Thailand*** by Arsomsilp Community and Environmental Architect + TURENSCAPE receives top honors, and ***System 02*** by The Backcountry Hut Company from Canada takes **Construction Product Design of the Year**. The emerging talents are equally celebrated: ***Timber & Table***, a unique concept by Luxi Chen, receives **Emerging Architect of the Year**. Sonal Aggarwal's striking work on the ***Yohji Yamamoto New York City Flagship Store*** is celebrated as **Emerging Interior Designer of the Year**. Finally, ***Exoskeletons in Taiwan*** by Cheng-Wei Lee is recognized as **Emerging Landscape Architect of the Year**.

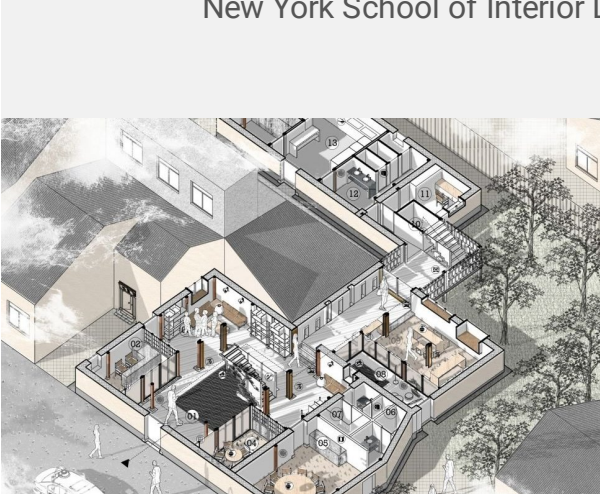
